

Chief Complaint

John Doe is a 59 year old male. His reason for visit is "I burp a lot after meals and have indigestion after I eat at night."

History of Present Illness

#1. "GERD": He reported: Treatment for gastrointestinal reflux disease.

Quality: He reported: Eructation. He denied: Abdominal pain.

Severity: He reported: Dyspepsia at least once a week. Esophagus symptoms are about the same in the last month. Esophagus symptoms are severe.

Timing: He reported: Esophagus symptoms last for several hours. Esophagus symptoms occur several times a week. He denied: Emesis frequent.

Context: He reported: Cough associated with eating. He denied: Sleep disturbed by esophagus symptoms.

Associated Signs and Symptoms: He denied: Dysphagia. Other esophagus related symptoms besides dyspepsia.

Past, Family, and Social History

Past Medical History

He denied: Using other measures to treat heartburn besides diet and medication.

Social History

Activities for Daily Living

History of: Esophagus symptoms definitely interferes with general activities (5/10).

Medication History

History of: Using regular prophylactic medication for heartburn and antacids.

He denied: Using medication to stop heartburn after it begins.

Past Medications

History of: Maalox. Pepto-Bismol. Roloids. Tums.

He denied: Using H2 blockers, cytoprotectants, anticholinergics, and proton pump inhibitors.

Adverse Drug Reactions

He denied: Dyspepsia associated with using certain medications.

Allergy History

Prior Available Laboratory Tests

He denied: Tests for dyspepsia within 6 months.

Review of Systems

Ear, Nose, and Throat

He denied: Globus sensation.

Cardiovascular

He denied: Exertional dyspepsia.
