

## **Chief Complaint**

Tommy Hill is a 6 year old male. Mother's reason for visit is "Tommy needs a check up for school."

## **History of Present Illness**

## **Past, Family, and Social History**

### **Pediatric History**

#### **Growth and Development**

History of: Child will not take turns. Child does not ask about sex. Child does not respond as expected to punishment.

Mother reported: Child can ride a bicycle with training wheels, keep up with other children during play, print name, and print complete alphabet. Draws people with 6 body parts. Child attends school outside the home. Child is starting to understand cause and effect. Child delays immediate gratification. Child shows desire to be more independent. Child progressing well learning to read and write.

#### **Social History**

History of: No one reads to child. Does not know if child follows household rules. Does not regularly participate in activities outside home.

Mother denied: Child has traveled outside North America during the past year. Child has difficulty making friends. Mother reported: Child can control anger. Child understands right and wrong. Child wants to participate in activities.

#### **Child Safety**

History of: Child has been warned about petting strange animals. Child plays on trampoline. Child rides snowmobile or ATV. Child is not learning to swim. Medicine cabinet is left unlocked. Guns are left unlocked or loaded. Allowing child to ride on a bicycle or tricycle without a helmet. Child does not ride in booster seat. Allowing child to play near water without a life jacket. Allowing child to be exposed to sun without either sunscreen or protective clothing. Discusses how to be safe with child.

Mother denied: Allowing child to be left home alone. Relies on screens to help keep child from falling out of windows. Allowing child to have access to matches or cigarette lighters. Allowing child to be left in the car alone for any period of time. Mother reported: Supervised care after school. Poison control number available by the telephone. Child always wears a seat belt in the car. Child understands fire danger.

#### **Parenting Issues**

History of: Parent does not set rules for behavior, does not praise good behaviors, spansks, slaps, or yells about unacceptable behavior, does not limit child's exposure to TV, does not limit child's exposure to video games, and does not give child regular chores. Not knowing what limits to set for child. Disagreement between partners on discipline.

Mother denied: Having other concerns that were not addressed.

Mother reported: Parent acts as a good role model.

## Review of Systems

### **Constitutional**

Mother reported: Concern about child's weight.

Mother denied: Child unwell today. Concern that child is not gaining enough weight.

### **Eye**

Mother denied: Concerns about child's ability to see and child's eyes.

### **Ear, Nose, and Throat**

Mother denied: Concerns about child's ability to hear.

### **Dental Health**

Mother reported: Child has had dentist visit. Child does not brush teeth at least twice daily.

Mother denied: Concerns about child's teeth.

### **Respiratory**

Mother denied: Concerns about child's breathing.

### **Gastrointestinal**

Mother reported: Child has hard stools. Concerns about child's bowel movements. Child strains to move bowels.

Mother denied: Child has loose or watery stools.

### **Genitourinary**

Mother denied: Concerns about child's urination and child's genitals.

### **Skin**

Mother denied: Concerns about child's skin.

### **Musculoskeletal**

Mother reported: Having concerns about child's height / weight.

### **Psychiatric**

Mother reported: Time outs not used as discipline.

## Risk Factors

### **Nutrition**

Mother reported: Child eats snacks between meals, small amounts of green vegetables, small amounts of yellow or orange vegetables, and small amounts of fruits. Parent is not teaching child about healthy foods and does not limit intake of high fat/sugar foods. Child drinks juice.
